

## Elementary School Wish List

Would you like to help? You can make a difference for our school and our students. There are various ways in which you can help. You may purchase specific items for classrooms, submit monetary donations for field trips or other items, or volunteer your time in many ways. Please read the following list and decide how you can be a part of continuing to provide excellent opportunities for our students.

### **Sponsor a field trip:**

- ❖ 4K students would like to travel to a local farm and a park in May. Estimated cost is \$75.00.
- ❖ 5K students would like to travel to the Children's Museum and a play in Eau Claire. Estimated cost is \$120.00.
- ❖ 1<sup>st</sup> grade students would like to travel to the Minnesota Zoo. Estimated cost for transportation is \$300.00. Student admission cost is \$175.00.
- ❖ 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> grade students' biennial (every other year) field trip focuses on the environment and nature study, with a trip to Beaver Creek Reserve.
- ❖ 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> grade students' biennial (every other year) field trip to Madison.

Estimated cost for 2<sup>nd</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> & 5<sup>th</sup> grade trips is \$500.00.

### **Purchase items:**

**4K class** – Art supplies (google eyes, sequins, buttons, etc). New or slightly used board games and puzzles, appropriate for 4-year olds (Candyland, Connect Four, etc.). Large area rug (solid color), electric pencil sharpener with adjustable pencil size, wooden train pieces and train table.

**5K class (Mrs. Evenson)** – Scrap paper for drawing (this could be reams of white typing paper or something kids can practice coloring or cutting with). A doll house with furniture and dolls.

**5K class (Ms. Schultz)** – Ziploc bags (all sizes), small clothespins, Tupperware stencil sets for kids (new or used). Empty, clean sour cream containers for paint and small items.

**1<sup>st</sup> Grade** – Pencils, stickers, scissors, picture books, erasers, card stock, art supplies (wiggly eyes, glitter, etc.). Age appropriate games/toys. CD/cassette player, children's magazines (new or used), Smart board.

**2<sup>nd</sup> Grade (Mrs. Larson)** – SD memory card for digital camera, Shark cordless sweeper for classroom, Hanes T-shirts (size-Children's Large), Ink Jet ink cartridges.

**2<sup>nd</sup> Grade (Mrs. Jusa)** – 13 Hanes T-shirts (size-Children's Large), Ink Jet ink cartridges, CD/cassette player.

**3<sup>rd</sup> Grade** – Ziploc bags (quart and gallon), floor cushions or bean bag chairs for the reading area. Board games (not battery operated) appropriate for 3<sup>rd</sup> graders, either new or in good condition. Step stool for storage room, rechargeable batteries and battery charger for digital camera.

**4<sup>th</sup> Grade** – #2 pencils, erasers, markers, colored pencils, crayons, sturdy pocket folders, 3' and 4' wood/metal bookcases, CD Player

**5<sup>th</sup> Grade** – CD player, book rack, display boards for the Science Fair, markers, beanbags or chairs for the reading center, money towards costumes/props for the Christmas program.

**For grades 2-5** – Monetary donations for purchasing literature libraries for use with our new Math Expressions series. Each set costs approximately \$85-\$90.

**For use by all staff for their classes** – Monetary donations for purchasing more AccuCut stencils. These are for a piece of equipment that cuts out the letters/designs desired, so there is no need to cut by hand. The letters/designs are used by the staff for decorating their classrooms, hallways and bulletin boards, or for learning activities. Each stencil costs between \$25-\$50.

**Music/Band department** – Costuming help for the Elementary Christmas programs. Organizing help for the Music Library. Any guitars or band instruments in playable condition that are presently not being used.

**Cross-Categorical class** – Ziploc bags, 4 calculators, a bean bag for quiet time. Seeds, dirt and pots for planting, 4 adult wooden chairs, arts & crafts kits for creating masterpieces, food box kits for cooking in the Life Skills class.

- ❖ 5K – Spanish/English speaking adult to read with bilingual kindergarten children once a week

- ❖ Volunteers to wrap bouquets for Christmas concerts
- ❖ Set design help for the Christmas programs
