

# WONEWOC-CENTER SCHOOL SUPPLIES FOR 2010-2011

*Please label everything including coats, hats, mittens, shoes & boots.*

## EC & 4-K - (Don't label supplies - we share.)

- 4 folders with pockets (keep extra's at home to use as spare)
- 10 glue sticks
- 1 large box of Kleenex
- 1 package of baby wipes
- 1 box crackers/cookies for snack
- 1 large backpack
- Labeled plastic bag with change of clothes

## Kindergarten - (Don't label supplies - they are shared.)

- 1 large box of Kleenex
- 6 glue sticks
- 4 folders (2-pocket)
- 1 box dry food for snack (crackers, cereal, etc.)
- Backpack
- Pair of inexpensive shoes for phy. ed.
- Labeled plastic bag with change of clothes.

## First Grade

- 1 large book bag
- 2 red (thicker) folders
- 2 green (thicker) folders
- 2 red notebooks - wide-lined
- 2 green notebooks - wide-lined
- 1 - 24 box of crayons
- 6 glue sticks
- 2 pink erasers
- Bottle of white glue
- 2 black Sharpie markers
- 2 packages pencils (not fancy plastic coated ones)
- 1 large box Kleenex
- Girls only - 1 box Ziploc sandwich bags
- Boys only - 1 box Ziploc gallon bags
- Each student **must** have a pair of audio headphones

## Second Grade - (Please don't label.)

- 3 folders with bottom pockets
  - 1 pencil box (regular 6 in. by 8 in. not the long ones)
  - 2 box of crayons (24 count) (Not Rose Art)
  - 1 large box of Kleenex (250-275 count)
  - 2 wide lined spiral notebooks (single subject)
  - 24 - #2 pencils (not fancy, they don't sharpen well)
  - 2 large pink erasers
  - 4 glue sticks
  - 1 bottle of Elmer's glue
  - 1 highlighter
  - 1 black fine point permanent marker
  - 1 3-ring binder - 1½ inch (not a trapper keeper)
  - Dry food for snack cupboard
  - Girls only - 1 box of Ziplock sandwich bags
  - Boys only - 1 box of Ziplock gallon size bags
  - Inexpensive set of audio headphones \*\*
  - optional: colored pencils or Twistables
- No pens, markers, or mechanical pencils**

## Third Grade

  - Inexpensive set of audio headphones \*\*

- Eraser
- 1 folder

- Folder
- Eraser
- Magic markers
- Calculator (solar) - useful, but not necessary
- 4 (Expo 2) BLACK Dry Erase markers (any type will work)
- Old sock or chalkboard eraser
- Inexpensive set of audio headphones \*\*

## 7<sup>th</sup> & 8<sup>th</sup> Grade

- 6 - book covers
- Grading pens for all classes (black & blue ink is preferred)
- Pencils for all classes
- Small dictionary (for social studies and reading)
- Colored pencils (to be used for social studies, science, & math)
- Loose leaf paper (for all classes)
- Notebook (for English)
- Folder (for careers)
- Graph paper (for math)
- Simple functioning calculator (for math)
- Family size box of Kleenex (for English)
- 4 - 1½ inch 3-ring binders with pocket (**BUY 4**) (One for each class: English, social studies, math, and science)
