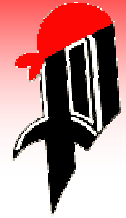


1:1 Laptop Student Expectations



As a learner I will...

1. Ensure that my laptop is charged every evening and ready for use the next day (i.e. plugging it in to the cart for charging overnight).
2. Look after my laptop very carefully all of the time.
 - a. Laptops must be situated securely on the working surface.
 - b. Make sure the laptop is not subject to careless or malicious damage (i.e. as a result of horseplay)
 - c. Take care when the laptop is transported that it is as secure as possible (not left unattended in school)
3. Store my laptop in my locker when not in use. (i.e. lunch, phy ed, etc.)
4. Carry my laptop in the closed position with two hands when inside the classroom.
5. Be on the task assigned by my teacher at all times.
6. Print only after teacher gives permission.
7. Not decorate the laptop and not allow it to be subject to graffiti.
8. Not install or download additional software.

Consequences for Violation of Laptop Rules

For every violation, a Student Behavior form will be completed and forwarded to the office for review. Violations may consist of infractions of the above mentioned and/or those of the District Acceptable Use policy. Depending on the severity of the infraction, the following steps may or may not be used in a progressive manner:

- Upon teacher discretion, student may lose laptop privileges for remainder of class.
- Student will meet with school-level administration and he/she will decide if student should lose laptop privileges for the day.
- Student will lose laptop privileges for 1 week.
- Student will lose laptop privileges indefinitely.
- Serious infractions including, but not limited to hacking, by-passing District filters, and or blatant misuse of the laptop, may result in immediate loss of privilege.
