



At the end of each year, students are recognized for their involvement and academic achievement throughout the school year. Listed below are the awards and the criteria that must be met to be eligible for the awards.



PRESIDENTIAL ACADEMIC EXCELLENCE AWARD

This award is presented to 8th grade students who have maintained an A- average through the first 10 quarters of their middle school career. Students who moved into the district during middle school will use the grades that are transferred into LCMS. Students in 6th and 7th grade should strive to receive this award as an 8th grade student and need to understand that grades in 6th and 7th grade help to determine who is presented with this award at 8th grade graduation.



BETTY ANN BRY'S MEMORIAL AWARD

This award is presented to an 8th grade student who has participated in either forensics and/or drama during their 8th grade year and displays the qualities of a fine middle school student.

Betty Ann Brys was a former math teacher at LCMS who was very involved with students and co-curricular activities. Her untimely death saddened both her current and former students, as well as District staff members and the community of Little Chute. A memorial fund was set up in her honor at the time of her death.

The student selected to receive this award will receive a \$50 savings bond, a personal plaque, and have his/her name engraved on the school plaque housed in the display case near the main office. The winner is announced at 8th Grade Graduation.



RICH VANDERWYST AWARD

The Rich VanderWyst award is given annually to an 8th grade student who displays the positive qualities of athletics in their everyday life, such as respect, citizenship, cooperation, honesty, and effort.

He or she must have participated in a LCMS sponsored sport their 8th grade year.

The student selected to receive this award will receive a personal plaque, and have his/her name engraved on the school plaque housed in the display case near the main office. The winner is announced at 8th Grade Graduation.



CITIZENSHIP AWARD

The Citizenship Award is given annually to an 8th grade student who demonstrates a concern for their fellow classmates, demonstrates the ability to contribute to school or class projects, and/or frequently volunteers to help fellow students and teachers. The students are nominated by LCMS teachers and once all nominees have been turned in, a ballot is created with the names of all nominees and the rationale for the nomination. Staff members at LCMS vote for one student on the ballot and the student with the most votes receives a \$50.00 savings bond and have his/her name engraved on the school plaque housed in the display case near the main office. The winner of this award is announced at 8th Grade Graduation.



KIWANIS LEADERSHIP AWARD

Each year the Little Chute Kiwanis Club honors two students from Little Chute Middle School who have distinguished themselves by demonstrating good citizenship. The students nominated must have demonstrated good citizenship and have provided service to their school and community. Students are nominated by a faculty member from LCMS. The winners of the award are announced at 8th Grade Graduation and each receives a \$50.00 savings bond
